# HARVEST FESTIFALL

The Columbia Harvest Festifall in Columbia State Historic Park is not a typical Arts & Crafts Fair. This is a fun-filled weekend for demonstrating and sharing hobbies and crafts, and enjoying music, dancing, kids activities, and the harvest season. The event is sponsored by the Columbia Chamber of Commerce.

We are looking for vendors to sell historically reminiscent products and items such as tinware, silver items, wood furniture, farm or garden items, artwork, quilts, soaps, candles, stitchery items, handspun or woven products, handmade jewelry, blown glass, copperwork, pottery, handmade food products. We encourage demonstrations of your craft making.

## REQUIREMENTS

- Historically reminiscent items and merchandise must be handcrafted by the seller. No imported or mass-produced items allowed.
- Booth display must use period-looking items, including baskets, barrels, wood, fabric, or canvas. No plastic items, including tarps. Cardboard boxes and aluminum tent or table legs must be hidden from view—tables must be draped. Chairs too, unless wooden. Booth size is 10' x 10'.
- Sellers must wear appropriate costumes from the 1850s to 1890s. Contact us for assistance regarding costumes.
- We allow shade canopies (neutral colors).

### Prospective sellers must return the following to be considered:

- Number of Seller's Permit, or Temporary Seller's Permit, from State Board of Equalization (BOE). A separate permit is needed for each of your selling locations—Apply to BOE in Sacramento for a permit listing 11255 Jackson St, Columbia, CA 95310 as the location of the craft fair. **But note this address is for the Columbia State Park office—do not send your application or questions there. Instead, contact Leslie (Columbia Chamber) as listed below.**
- Completed Application Form (see page 2)
- Check or Money Order payable to **Columbia Chamber of Commerce**
- If you're new to the Harvest Festifall, mail or email photos of your products for sale, and of your booth and costume.
- If we cannot send your acceptance to you using email, please provide a business size self-addressed stamped envelope (SASE) so your acceptance can be mailed.
